Finnish-Argentinian Circularity Weeks in Rovaniemi, Kokkola, Sonka and Pyhätunturi includes seminars, workshops and an intensive course on 'Circularity in Polar regions: From theory to practice' for Finnish and Argentinian students, taught by teachers from four Finnish and Argentinian universities. **CIBIECO project** focuses on the ideas of the circular bio-economy and their practical implementation in two polar regions – Finland (Lapland and Ostrobothnia) and Argentina (Tierra del Fuego and Cordoba). It combines research, teaching and local communities working life. The comparative aspect of the project reinforces the question of the ways of 'translating' circular concepts and approaches into practice, their benefits and limits in the context of a spatial and cultural application.
