Conference Program

The event will begin with an inaugural session, followed by plenary and breakout sessions, and theme-based workshops. Please review the program details that have been uploaded to the website.

Breakout Sessions

The breakout sessions will run in three parallel sessions. Each session will last 90 minutes and feature four panellists plus a Moderator/Chair. Presenters will have 10–15 minutes for their oral presentations, followed by a question-and-answer session after each talk, and, if time permits, a discussion at the end of the panel.

The seminar rooms will be equipped with standard amenities. Presenters may use PowerPoint slides. We recommend limiting your slides to eight to ten and providing a clear set of key takeaways at the end of your presentation. Please bring your presentation on a USB drive. As the event approaches, we may also request that you send your file to a designated email address.

Speakers' bios: As a breakout session speaker, we recommend that you prepare a short bio to deliver to the session chair either before the conference or immediately before your session. Please find the chair of your session in the published conference program.

Workshops

Three interactive workshops will be held during the conference, involving all participants and organized around the central theme: *Cryosphere, People, and Climate Change*. Participants will be divided into three groups, and the discussions will be guided by a set of questions/agenda prepared by the workshop chair. Your input will be valuable and will be used to prepare a white paper to present at COP 30 in Brazil this year. Please prepare accordingly. More information will be available in the program.
